As my part in our Eben Haeser thank-offer memorial: I promise to pay to the Consistory of the Reformed Church " " " as trustee One Hundred Dollars with seven percent p.a. to be paid semiannually, untill Said Sum is paid, with the express condition: that this Sum as a part of said memorial fund shall, when paid in, permanently be invested by mortgage of real estate, and that said trustee shall pay the interest to Hope College treasurer as tuition for the Grammar School of said college. — This note is transferable to the Council of Hope College as soon as this memorial fund shall be efficient, and in a condition to be delivered up as a whole and in a tangible form. —

 when paid in permanently be invested by mortgage of real estate; and
 that said trustees shall pay the interest to the college
 treasurer, as tuition for the Grammar School of ^{the} college.

 and in a condition to be delivered up as a whole and
 in a tangible form.
