Albertus van Raalt (father of Albertus)

Eerst was hy Predikant te Brandwoude van 1794
tot 1811. - Voorts te Waaneparteen van 1811-1820
van daar werd hy herwaerts beroepen 11 December
1819. en bevestigd 7 Mei 1820. door den Consulair
Buis Raalt met Coll. 1.20 en deed intrede met
twee Cor: 4.5. In December 1821. beroepen na Nij-
"Soord e.ö. Predikant hy afscheid 20 April 1822.
met Hebr: 10: 28.23. van Nijsoord nam hy afscheid
23 October 1825. met 1 Cor. 16. 23. 24 en werd be-
vestigd te Scherpenisse 30 October 1825. hy vertrok
van hier naar Fynawid e.ö. na deet hy beroepen
was 16 Mei 1828. en afscheid gepredikt had
27 July. te Fynawid overleed hy 28 Maart
1833. oud 61 jaar en 6 maanden.

Albertus van Raalte

First he was Pastor at Renswoude from 1794 until 1811.
Then at Wanneperveen from 1811-1820.
He was called from there on December 11, 1819
and installed the 7th of May 1820 by the counselor
Buis Ballot with Coll. 1:20, and preached his inaugural
with 2 Cor. 4:5. In December 1821 he was called to
Rijsoord and environs and preached his farewell on
April 28, 1822 using Heb. 10:23. He took his leave
from Rijsoord on October 23, 1825 using 1 Cor. 16:23, 24,
and was installed at Scherpenisse on October 30, 1825.
He departed from there to Fijnaard and environs after having
received the call on the 16th of May 1828 and having preached
his farewell on July 27. He died at Fijnaard on the 28th of
March 1833, at the age of 61 years and 6 months.
