that I have been going
away from you as fast as
steam can carry me, since
Monday. We are having a
glorious trip, now don't
think I am home sick, but
I won't be sorry when the cars
are carrying me the other way.
Oh! the scenery of yesterday +
today have been so magnifi-
cent that mama's pen can not
portray it to you but when I
get back, if God permits it,
won't I have a lot to tell you.
Yesterday we reached the

highest altitude a party of us went into the baggage car as the best place for seeing as we went through the pass. When we were up so high it was very cold, I had to have a wrap on. Snow on the mountains, making hay, + a regular thunder storm, all in sight, + Leadville only four miles away, and in plain sight. Many of the ladies were moved to tears at the grandeur of the "Royal Canon". As we went through "Castle gate" an hour ago it took two engines to pull us. we are in the center of a block of

cars we counted six
engines in sight. We have
just seen a regular caravan
driving their cattle before them
hundreds of cows + horses.

We are just now stopping for
a look at Utah Lake.
