Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of  
Two hundred and forty Dollars

to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is  
hereby confessed and acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell, remise, release,  
alien and confirm unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and  
assigns, Forever, All that certain pieces or parcels of land situated

in the Township of Holland the County of Ottawa and the  
State of Michigan, known and described as city lots in  
the City of Holland, to wit: Lots number Four (IV) and  
Nine (IX) in Block numbered fifty one (LI) according to the  
Original and explanatory maps thereof on record.

Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in  
anywise appertaining. To Have and to Hold the said premises as described, with the appur-

tenances, unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns,  
forever. And the said parties of the first part, for themselves and their heirs,  
executors, and administrators do covenant, grant, bargain and agree to and  
with the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, that at the time of the  
enacting and delivery of these presents, they are well seized of the above granted  
premises, in Fee Simple: That they are free from all incumbrances whatever; and that they  
will, and their heirs, executors, and administrators, shall Warrant and  
Defend the same against all lawful claims whatsoever.
