of the second part, at or before the ensembling or delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, assigned, transferred and set over, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, assign, transfer and set over unto the said parties of the second part, a certain

do hereby for myself and for my heirs, executors and administrators, covenant, promise and agree to and with the said parties of the second part, that there is at this date due upon the said promissory note and Mortgage the sum of Seven hundred and nineteen dollars and seventeen cents, of principal and interest

and that I have good right and lawful authority to grant, bargain and sell the same in manner aforesaid.
