Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of *Two*

Hundred and fifty Dollars

to *Said Consistory* in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof

is hereby confessed and acknowledged, do *ed* by these presents grant, bargain, sell, remise, release, alien

and confirm unto the said party of the second part, and to *his* heirs and assigns

Forever, *All that certain piece or parcel of land situated*

in the Township of Holland County of Ottawa State of

Michigan and particularly bounded and described as

a piece of land commencing at the North East corner of

the North West quarter of the North East quarter in Section

Thirty Six (36) Town Five North Range Fifteen (15) and

running thence South Seventy four Rods (74) thence

West Twenty one Rods (21) 16 Links, thence North Seventy

four (74) Rods, thence East 21 Rods and 16 Links to

place of beginning and containing ten acres of land

Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in

anywise appertaining.
