This Indenture, Made this *Sixth* day of *August*

in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and *Seventy Five*

Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of *One*  
Dollar

to *Him* in hand paid by the said parties of the second part, the receipt whereof  
is hereby confessed and acknowledged, doeth by these presents grant, bargain, sell, remise, release, alien  
and confirm unto the said parties of the second part, and to *their* heirs and assigns

Forever, *All that certain parcel of land situated in the city of Holland*

*County of Ottawa and State of Michigan, described and bounded as follows:*  
*On the West Side by Tannery addition till you come from the waters of Black Lake*  
*to the quarter Post between sections Twenty Nine and Thirty, thence along the*  
*Eight Street Twenty Six Yards East, Thence North to the waters of Black Lake*  
*Running around the South West corner and along the West line of a piece ground laying on the*  
*water, and heretofore sold and deeded to P. Van den Berg; thence along*  
*the waters of Black Lake till you come to and against the*  
*East Line of Lot number One (1) of Tannery Addition in the city of Holland as*  
*it is on record in the recording office of Ottawa county State of Michigan.*

Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in  
anywise appertaining.
