This Indenture, Made this *Third* day of *May* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and *Seventy Six*

BETWEEN *Johannus Vandewate and Cornelia Vandewate his wife of the City of Holland County of Ottawa and State of Michigan* of the first part, and *Bernardus Lodiboev of the City of Holland County of Ottawa State of Michigan* of the second part,

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of *Fifty* Dollars

to *them* in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell, remise, release, alien and confirm unto the said party of the second part, and to *his* heirs and assigns

Forever, *All the right title and interest in that certain tract or parcel of land which is situated in the City of Holland County of Ottawa and State of Michigan and therein described as the West Side 15) & 16) of Lot Number Four (4) in Block number Sixty nine (69) in said City of Holland according to the recorded plat thereof on record as of the Village of Holland in the Register's office for Ottawa County*

Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining.

To Have and to Hold the said premises as described, with the appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part, and to *his* heirs and assigns, forever. And the said parties of the first part, for *themselves their* heirs, executors, administrators and assigns do covenant, grant, bargain and agree to and with the said party of the second part, *his* heirs and assigns, that at the time of the ensembling and delivery of these presents, *they are* well seized of the above granted premises, in Fee Simple. That they are free from all incumbrances whatever; and that *they* will, and *their* heirs, executors, administrators and assigns shall Warrant and Defend the same against all lawful claims whatsoever.
