Witnesseth, That the said part *2* of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of *One*
Dollar to *them*

in hand paid by the said parties of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged,
do *es* by these presents, grant, bargain, sell, remise, release, alien and confirm unto the said part *is* of the second
part, and *their successors* heirs and assigns, Forever, All *that* certain piece or parcel of
Land, situate and being in the *Township* of *Olive* County of
Ottawa and State of Michigan, *Particularly known*

and described as follows, to wit: *West half of the South*
West quarter of Section Twenty Five (25) in Town
Six (6) North Range Fifteen West, known as the Township
of Olive in Ottawa County State of Michigan.

For the purpose of procuring for each of the
Children of A. C. Van Raalte a Christian Library
and a Library book case, and sufficient aids
for Sabbath School and Catechetical instruction,
also for spreading ^{the truth} Bible and Tract Society,
and labor among the Jews.

Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise apper-
taining: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said premises, as *herein* described, with the appurtenances,
unto the said part *is* of the second part, and to *their successors* heirs and assigns, Forever. And the said

granted premises in Fee Simple: that they are free from all incumbrances whatever,

and that he will, and his heirs, executors, and administrators shall **WARRANT AND DEFEND** the same against all lawful claims whatsoever,
