igan, and is described by the United States survey as
the west half of the South West Quarter of Section Twenty
Nine, in Township Five North of Range Fifteen West, in
Containing according to said survey Eighty acres more
or less.

Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any
wise appertaining; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said land

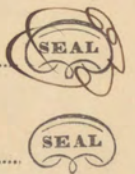
to the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, to the sole and only proper
