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Plum Catsup.

To 3 lbs. of fruit put one $\frac{1}{2}$ & 3 quarters lbs of sugar one tablespoonful of cloves, one table spoon of cinnamon, one tablespoonful of pepper & very little salt. Scald the plums and put them through a colander, then boil until about the consistency as tomato catsup.

Pound Pears.

To six lbs of pears, 3 lbs. of sugar $\frac{1}{2}$ pt. of water; boil and scum it well; then put in four pears, the rind of an orange and the juice of a lemon; boil slowly 3 hrs.

Cream Cake

1 cup sugar $\frac{1}{2}$ flour 3 eggs 2 table spoons ^{water} flour
1 table spoon baking powder Bake in 2 cakes.
Cream 1 pt. milk, 1 cup sugar $\frac{1}{2}$ cup butter
3 eggs, 2 table spoons flour lemon extract.
Cut each cake and fill with cream
